

About OSCAR

OSCAR is a **comprehensive, web-based, open source**, Electronic Medical Record (**EMR**) developed by **McMaster University**.

It has been designed to meet the needs of **Research and Academics** in a **clinical environment**.

OSCAR is **customizable** to accommodate a wide variety of research, education, language and clinical needs.

An **award winning** system, among the first EMR systems to pass **CMS Conformance Testing 3.0**.

OSCAR has **no licensing fees** and lower monthly support costs, making it the **most affordable full service EMR solution** for all sizes of physician practices in hospitals and in the community.

OSCAR consists of a **suite of applications** designed to help improve an organization's ability to provide the highest level of care possible, including –

- **OSCAR** - an Electronic Medical Record (**EMR**) system for clinic operations (Charting, reporting, appointments, billings, encounters, prescriptions, labs, decision support, secure messaging etc.)
- **MyOSCAR** – a Patient-Controlled Electronic Health Record (**PCHR**) accessible from any compliant web-application, based on the *Indivo* project from Harvard/MIT
- **MyDRUGRef** – a clinical decision support system (**CDSS**) and network for pharmacists and physicians to facilitate knowledge transfer of drug information. It is also fully integrated with the OSCAR EMR.
- **OSCAR Resource** – a compilation of **clinical resources** which can be accessed through the EMR at point of care.
- **OSCAR CAISI** – a **case** management, **bed** management and **program** facility **management** system.
- **eForms and Templates** – **Customizable** based on users requirements

In **Ontario**, **OSCAR** has a vibrant user community of about **430 physicians**, supporting approximately **650,000 patients**.

In **Canada**, **OSCAR** has been adopted in **Quebec, PEI, Alberta** and **British Columbia** supporting more than **750 physicians** translating into **over 1 million Canadians** patients.
